AUGUST 1ST TO 7TH

ON AUGUST 1ST: We were in 2 remote schools where over 2000 children and teens crowded in for our teaching. Many of them hadn't had opportunity before to hear about Jesus.

Please keep praying for each child reached that day. That the seed of God's word will grow in them – and for many of these young people to join our correspondence program.



New Children's Booklet: Please make this a priority for prayer this month. Most children in Thailand don't have books available to buy, or the money to buy them. These booklets can be a treasure for many of them. Please pray for each one who is working on this new booklet.



AUGUST 8TH TO 14TH

School Library Project: Since January, copies of last year's booklet have been sent to 4,478 Thai schools (in 9 provinces). More than 30,000 schools in 68 provinces are still waiting for their copies! Please pray for the resources needed (more Team members and more booklets) to meet this need.

Research among adults who did our lessons as children, and are now following the Lord, showed that 60% had their first contact with Jesus when they read one of our booklets in their school library.

Correspondence Lessons: Hope these letters help show some needs of children who study with us

Jantahom: Please pray for my parents to understand about Jesus and that they will believe in Him. Also pray that they will let me go to church.

Pimpilo: God is a very good counselor for me in every kind of problem. But sometimes when I have problems I start to doubt God. Please pray for me.

Thida: Having God in my life means I have someone who is always with me and loves me, and who will forgive me when I do wrong.

Ploenjit: God's word made me know His love is very great. I'm learning to apply His word in my life

Rachadapon: I want to know God more and feel closer to Him. Can you please pray for me

August 11th - School Outreaches in Chonburi: The Team is going to 3 schools today. Please pray for God's protection on them all, and His anointing and blessing on all that is taught today; also for God's Spirit to open the heart of each child who hears His word today.

Tribal Children's Home (House of Blessing): This home continues to care for over 100 needy tribal children and teens. Please pray for them, and also for Valerie who will visit there this week for time with the children and for discussions and mentoring with the Home's leadership team.

AUGUST 15TH TO 21ST

New Children's Booklet: Please keep praying for this – for Nok who is the editor, and for NoiNon, John and Peter(Pum) doing the artwork. Also for One, Bow and Doi who're helping write articles.

Correspondence Lessons: Please pray for each child studying with us, that they may understand and apply the truths they are learning. Several have written recently to tell of healing and protection.

Wassana: *I was alone at our home on the mountain and that day it rained heavily. Then a thunder storm came with gales. I was very afraid. I started to pray and ask Jesus to protect me and everyone in my village. I prayed for only about 3minutes. Suddenly everything calmed down. God does listen!*

Mattana 15 yrs: *My mother was very sick with malaria. I kept praying for her for 2 wks. Now she is better. I thank God. He healed her. Our family is poor but God cares for us and answers my prayer.*

Narhay: *Last month I had a very sore leg. I was in a lot of pain for days. On Monday I started to ask God to heal me. I prayed until Thursday, and then God did heal me.*

Pantara is married with a child, but still gets Susu: *On June 18th our daughter was very sick with malaria and a temperature of 39.4. The doctor said it was very dangerous. I began crying as he said that. I kept praying all that day. And God answered. Now our daughter is completely well again.*

Team News:

Doi: For family reasons Doi has had to take another job closer to her parents' home. She continues to help the Team part-time as much as she can, and is also part of the worship team at Nonthaburi Church and with the FahSai Club. Please pray for God's continued leading in her life.

Nok: Nok has been troubled with an eye infection for the past few weeks, and has needed to go to a specialist. Please pray with her that her eye will be totally healed.

Children reached in Schools this month:

Please continue to pray for each child in school outreaches this month. May God's Spirit continue to work in their hearts, and give them a real hunger to know Him and study His word.



Correspondence Lessons: Its always encouraging to see specific ways that God shows His love to Thai children as they do our lessons. For these two boys, God was with them in their sport ...

Suthirat: *As I learn about God I think He can help me a lot in my life. My dream is to be a takraw player. I always thank God that He is in my life. He helps me when I practice new kicks for takraw.*

Prasit: *This is how God helped me. In my soccer team we're all small and we had to play a team where they were all bigger. I asked God to help our team. I could hardly believe it, but our team won!*

For others their specific needs are related to schooling. Many are learning to trust God in this area:

Rassanee: *I don't think I could get by at school if I didn't have God with me.*

Kanjana: *I always failed in math and English. Since I came to know God I've prayed about this and my prayers have been answered. Now I can understand these subjects much better.*

Malee: *Sometimes at school I don't understand. So I pray to God and he helps me to understand.*

Thanchanok: *I nearly failed my exams, but then I didn't because I prayed and trusted in God.*

Chanthana: *I'm slow at study and that makes me discouraged. But now I pray to God to help and after that I can pass. Please pray for me not to get down so easily.*
