

THANKS FOR PRAYING: FOR SCHOOL OUTREACHES in Petchaboon, and for the Team who went up there – NoiNon, Jean, Narutai, Doi, Ganya and Art. Here are some of their comments ...

Doi: These outreaches were special. Only 6 of us could go so it was a heavy work load. But at each school we saw God help each of us use our special gifts and talents. **Also**, I was excited to meet 2 more Christian teachers in 2 different schools there. They want to help their children do our lessons

Art: I thank God we could sow seeds and we saw the children's genuine interest. Hundreds have applied to get our lessons. Seeing the joy on their faces gave me strength even when we were tired.

Jean: These schools are in my home area and my father came with us to each school so that was special for me. We saw village children and people in the local church get a desire to serve God.

Ganya: I was concerned we did not have younger Team members. But in the schools we had so much joy as we worked together. The children didn't notice our age but saw only our happiness.

Narutai: Some local believers took time off work to help us in schools. After we'd taught in a school we prayed for Jesus to bless each child and we saw they really asked for that too from their hearts.

Correspondence Lessons: These are always ongoing. As well, the numbers of children studying with us have multiplied incredibly this year, so there are always hundreds of lessons to catch up on after school outreaches. Pray for each Team member handling the lessons - Narutai, Jean, Wan, Bow, Nok and Doi – to always see each child as an individual and give the special attention that each one needs. Pray too for each child. Their needs and understanding vary but God's Spirit teaches them as we pray

Pondpon, who's 15: *I've never received a birthday present in my life. Then you sent me one. Thank you! These lessons help me in my life. I now know that God is very great. He is able to do anything for us because He loves us – even though we have made Him sad too.*

Supharat, who's 11: *Thank you for these free lessons. From them I learnt that Jesus can be with us wherever we are. Whenever I pray to God about things I feel very good!*

Benjamas, who's 14: *I asked God for something impossible and that was a high exam score. I couldn't get that in my own strength, I knew. I came in first in my class - unbelievable! God is real and does help us.*

Chatchanok, who's 17: *I wanted to go to church but was afraid to go alone. I asked God for courage. Now I thank God I did go. Everyone was friendly. It is a warming place, and I feel very happy when it is Sunday*
