Here are comments from some Team members before and after going to Chiang Rai...

Before the 8 hour drive up there	After they returned from these Schools
<p>One: My desire is for these children to understand Christ better. To truly know Him and grow up in Him, and be able to tell future generations, so that 10 years from now Jesus would be known in their area. This is my first time to visit a remote area.</p>	<p>One: I knew a Christian teacher arranged this so I thought we'd meet children who knew Jesus. But only at Prateep's school was that true. Other schools were in remote areas where the children had never before heard of Jesus! They were so interested - as if our news was something brand new. All teachers at those schools were Buddhist and our message was so new for them too. But I thank God we saw only smiles on their faces as we taught about Jesus.</p>
<p>Doi: I want the Lord to help me find Christian teachers in Thai schools who could be like spiritual mentors to help children to be able to walk with Christ. For older and newer members in our Team I pray we will all understand the team's vision with more clarity and be united in it.</p>	<p>Doi: Yes! We met several Thai Christian teachers, including Prateep (who arranged our visits to the schools) & Piyanch and their son & daughter-in-law - all teachers, who use every opportunity to share the Gospel. For 17yrs, Prateep & Piyanch have given children our booklets and helped them do our lessons – and mailed the lessons for each child. Now at their school so many children love Jesus. We knew we were there to have a part in building up their faith.</p>
<p>Narutai: I'm glad for this time as our Team can pray and serve the Lord together, We know that we are fighting a spiritual warfare, but God is greater and we believe for His victory.</p>	<p>Narutai: Each school had large Buddha images and teachers wore Buddhist amulets, yet no one opposed our message. Children were very responsive to Christ. A bonus was to find Christian leaders in that area who had done our lessons as children and that is how they came to know Jesus.</p>
<p>Art: My vision is for Thai children to come to know Christ and be rescued from the evil of our society. May they learn to love and follow Jesus.</p>	<p>Art: When I saw the children so receptive and sincere to the gospel, I knew God was answering my vision. It is a motivation and guidance for me to continue to serve Him in this way. Thank you for praying for me and my family.</p>
<p>Ganya: My desire is to see all on our Team filled with God's anointing and joy in every school, and see children with a desire to learn about Jesus. Jay: I want to see God's seed widely sown and fall on good soil. Hope to see many new students studying with us and learning about Christ!</p>	<p>Noionon: Bringing God's word in schools is my heart vision, and especially when we go to unreached areas. I know when we reach children we may not see immediate results, but we can believe for more fruit in the long run. I was very impressed to see so many kids from Prateep's school who study with us, and see his dedication to help children for so many years. Please keep praying for all these children in Chiang Rai who study with us.</p>

PLEASE KEEP PRAYING: For Prateep, Piyanch and their son and daughter-in-law (she also came to know Jesus when she did our lessons as a child). Pray for continued strength for these four as they help more children have our lessons. Pray against opposition from fellow teachers and parents.

Buahom: My problem was my parents wouldn't let me go to church. I prayed and now God has helped me

Buthor: I'm very bad with math, so I was afraid that I would not pass a math exam. In the end I prayed and God really helped me to pass. Now I have accepted Christ as my saviour.

Namphon: In my family are many problems. I pray about these to solve them. I really want to go to church, but I don't know what to tell my grandma, because she doesn't like Christians. Also I want to know why sometimes, when we ask God for something, He doesn't answer.
