Children doing the CORRESPONDENCE LESSONS learn in different ways as God speaks to them ...

JUNE 17TH TO 23RD

School Outreaches in Pitsanulok – 18th to 22nd: We'll work in these schools with Sittipong (who was in Nonthaburi) and the Church he works with near Pitsanulok. Please pray for God to be with each of us in these schools, protect us and anoint us with His power and wisdom. Please keep praying for open and hungry hearts for each child. Our program includes fun, as well as telling all that Christ has done for us. We see varying reactions as children begin to think about all they're hearing.



Children with needs:

Many Thai children have needs and especially those from poor families with little protection when things happen in their lives or in their family situations. Please pray they'll turn to God for help.

Phattraporn: *I am very glad that you didn't forget me and wrote to me again. Our house was flooded up to the roof and we lost many things. And I lost your address. Also I couldn't find the New Testament you sent me. Can I ask you to please send me a new one. I do want to read it again.*

Prangwadee: *Our house was burnt down. We had nowhere to live for a while. I lost my diploma for doing the first six lessons and the New Testament. I missed your letters too but I didn't have your address and couldn't send my last lesson. Now I just received your letter and you sent that lesson again. Thank you. I'm very happy to know that you still care about me.*

Orathai (15): *When I have problems now I pray for God to help me and guide me. A big problem is that my parents fight always. Also my family is poor and don't have enough money for me to stay in school. Please pray for me about this.*

Sarutha: *I have 11 brothers and sisters. Our parents don't have enough money to pay for us all to go to school and they always fight about this. Please pray for me and for God to help me study.*

JUNE 24TH TO 30TH

For each Child who heard God's Word in their School last week: Please keep praying for them. The seed went into good soil, prepared by our prayers. May many begin our lessons. May God's Spirit help each one keep thinking of all they heard, and give a growing desire to know and follow Christ.

Yearly Children's Booklet – From now on we'll concentrate on this. We're also calling in help from Faith and others with expertise in cartooning. Please pray for them, and for God's Spirit to anoint each one of us and give His inspiration and creativity for every part of this booklet. Correspondence Lessons: Often children refer to difficulties at school and ask for prayer about this. Its always encouraging to see how God shows Himself to children in specific ways and helps them.

Pichaporn (13): *At school I didn't understand but I was afraid to ask the teacher. So then I didn't understand it even more. Can you pray for God to help me.*

Suwarat (14): *I've been trying to do some hard things. Like loving people who are not good to me - who say they're sorry and then do bad things again. Also I wanted to do better at school. I always took a long time to understand any of our school lessons. When I came to know Jesus I asked Him to help me be cleverer. And now I can understand our lessons much better than before.*

Patraporn, (10): *I asked God for wisdom and in the exam I could answer it all. I thank God He did give me wisdom and I was in the top 3 in our class. My first time to do that.*
