FOR SCHOOLS IN MUKDAHAN

Team members wrote their prayers re our week there. Then ... the answers they saw.

Wan(One): I prayed all the teachers will listen and understand that Jesus is the true God and can be our Saviour.

... Each teacher listened throughout and looked interested too. None went to do other work. Those I spoke to did understand our story's meaning. I saw what can happen if we give ourselves and our story to God, and trust in His love.



Ganya: I asked God to deliver children from the belief in magic and spirit worship that surrounds them in their lives. Instead may they seek to know God and give their lives to follow Him.

... My faith was tested. I had severe pain in my knee as we got to Mukdahan. It got worse. I couldn't walk and said "I can't go to schools like this." At once, Doi and Wan prayed for me. Then all pain was gone. I think it was a spiritual attack.

NoiNon: I wanted to see church leaders in Mukdahan catch our vision for children to become disciples. May they be burdened



as I am to take every chance to reach kids whose hearts are open to God. I resolved to talk to them about doing follow-up.

MARCH 1ST TO 10TH

Correspondence Lessons: Many letters came last month. Pray for Team members who answer them, and for these 3 boys & 3 girls with very different stories, and for all the 12 & 13yr olds they represent

Somchai (13): I used to think - why is that I am alone and no one cares about me. But when I read the Bible then I knew that God is beside me and is always with us.

Thananay (12): I'm amazed by what Jesus did. I didn't want Him to die. Then I learned He loves us so He came to help us. I'd like to know what Jesus looks like.

Kumpon (13): The story in Matt. 7 about a tree and its fruit speaks to my heart. What we do shows who we are

Behlia (12): I'd really would like my parents to learn these lessons too so they can know God.

Roognapa (13): In the lessons I learned that Jesus Christ loves everyone and He died for us. Although we are not always good but Jesus always loves and cares for us.

Rachadapon (12): I had the chance to go to the church. It was very good. Everyone there was very kind and it was fun too. I feel God blesses me in many things.

The **Correspondence Lessons** are our focus this month. Please pray for Doi, Jeen, Wan(One), Bow, Ganya and Dang who all work with these lessons and answer children's letters.

Also we'll be working on some new lessons this month. Please pray for God's creativity and anointing for all who work on these.

MARCH 11TH TO 17TH

Exams: March is the month for the main exams in Thai schools. Most children writing to us have asked for prayer regarding these.

Schools Outreaches: There'll be none this month or next – because of exams this month and then the summer holidays in April. But please pray for ...

All Children reached during January & February:

Please keep praying for each child who heard God's word in their school. May that word continue to go deep into their hearts

Pray also for the families of these children, that others will be attracted to the Lord through them.

Pray especially for any children who are not yet allowed to begin doing our lessons.

Pray for children who're facing opposition – may God may make His presence real to them and do miracles on their behalf to keep them close to Him.

... But, the first thing they said was – “We want to help children be able to do the correspondence lessons, and come to Jesus and follow Him.” They all came with us to each school. They got to know the teachers and talked to them about encouraging children to do our lessons.

Dang: From Psalm 40:9-10, I prayed I'd have God's faith and boldness, hope and love as we go to schools. May each child know how much God loves them and have a deep desire to know the Lord.

... I saw God answer **all** these prayers.

Art: I pray we'll be like a farmer planting rice seeds. May each child be like a seed that produces many new seeds among family and friends. I pray many come to the Lord through each child we reach.

... As I saw the children's determination to listen I had faith to believe that every seed we planted is going into good soil.

Doi: I prayed children in each school will sense God is with us and have a hunger to know God. I prayed many will do our lessons even if its difficult to find a post office or have money for stamps.

... As we met those church leaders I was thrilled to see how they value children and their passion to reach them. **They said,** “We'll divide the schools up among ourselves and go visit them regularly to help children start doing your lessons.”

MARCH 18TH TO 24TH

Correspondence Lessons: It's great to see how God makes His word relevant to these 17 yr old girls...

Saisudah: I enjoy lessons about prayer. Many times God has answered. Here's the best answer- My grandfather used to drink a lot. That started many family problems I didn't know what to do so I asked God to help. God answered immediately. From that day my grandfather just stopped drinking and has had no alcohol since.

Rasamee – she just sent back a lesson and a letter to Doi. She said, “thank you for introducing me to Jesus in the lessons. Now I want to help for your work.” She sent 60 baht (\$2.50). Her response blessed us all.

Supaworn: For my friend's birthday we decided to give her money. That day I had 50Baht left for all week. I had been learning God can take care of me so I gave it all. Next day my youth leader gave me an envelope with 300 Baht in it. I think God did a miracle for me
