OCTOBER 1ST TO 7TH

Introducing children to a local Church: Many children want to go. We try to contact a Church near them to help the children get there. Sometimes it's too far to travel, or family won't let them go. Pray for miracles to help each child be able to get to a Church.

OCTOBER 8TH TO 14TH

Preparation for next week's Youth Camp: Team members going to this Camp are NoiNon, Doi, Dang and Corin. They'll be group leaders, lead devotional times, and also they'll take a workshop on 'The Value and Methods of Teaching Thai Children about Christ'. These four ask for prayer especially that God's Spirit will lead them in their preparation and give His creative ideas.

Correspondence Lessons and Letters:

One thing many children want to learn about is prayer as you can see in these letters. Please pray they'll grow in their trust in God and grow closer to Him as they keep turning to Him in prayer.

Jeeranant (11): *Before our Thai language test I asked God to help me. Then I had the highest mark. One friend said she also prayed and why didn't she pass. I asked if she believed God could help when she prayed. She said no. I told her you have to trust that God can help you. She said ok. We prayed together and at the re-sit she passed with a high grade too.*

Pornthip (14): *I couldn't find my room key anywhere. I searched for a long time and felt helpless. So I prayed. Then I found it.*

Wilaiporn (15): *At times I do badly at school. Then I get stressed until I get a headache. But if I ask God for help then I don't get discouraged and I remember He is with me always.*

Porree (15): *Please pray for my father. I know God can help me and my family.*

Kultida (14): *I finished late at school and had to walk home alone. I saw a motorbike gangster watching me. I was very afraid so I prayed and kept walking. Then he got on his bike and left.*

New Cartoon Booklet: Please pray that most of the Booklet can be finished this week. Pray for Faith who has some pages to finish, but is also needing knee surgery soon. This booklet's potential is huge. It may be the only Christian message many thousands of Thai children ever see or hear.

Pornpailin (12): *The lessons help me know what sin is and that Jesus died to forgive our sin.*
