SEPTEMBER 1ST TO 16TH

Correspondence Lessons: Hope these two letters help reflect the needs of some who study with us and also what God is doing in their lives and through them. Please pray that each child doing the lessons will experience God in their lives as they study His word. Pray too for Team members as they reply to the comments and questions of such a variety of young people.

Jeeranan, a girl of 17: *I have a question. If I’m Buddhist, can I believe in Jesus? Last month my friends and I represented our school in an English competition. Our group had low scores. So I asked God to help me. In the next part we got the highest score so I think Jesus did help us.*

Chatchawarn, a boy of 13: *My friend had problems and was unpopular because of things he said and did. I have been telling him about Jesus. Now he believes in Jesus and already he has started to change into a much better person so people like him more.*

New Booklet: For this month also this is our main prayer need. All on the Team have really risen to the challenge of this project, but it’s a big job and there are still over 20 pages needing to be written and designed. Thanks for your continued prayers for us all.

Booklets going to School Libraries:

This project continues with packets of our booklets going to hundreds of schools. Earlier this year the response from schools was less than usual. So the Team began praying specifically for this project and also prepared a new leaflet introducing the booklets and our Team. Just in one day this month we received 80 enrolment forms from children who had been reached in this way. Please pray for each of these children as they begin our lessons.

Team News: News of two young men who have just started to work in our Team.

Corin is settling in well and his 3yrs Bible school training means he is been able to help in many ways, ranging from teaching to postal duties, and also data input.

Nuum came to the Lord in the FahSai Club and has been in the worship team there for some time.

He’s now at a vocational college and has asked to do his 2 month job assignment with the Team. He’s a big help with all the data input involved when a child enrolls in our correspondence program, and he is also very excited at the opportunity to learn the Team’s work.

Wimolwan, a girl of 12: *I wanted so much to go to one famous school but then I had to go to another school and I thought God didn't help me. But now I am happy in my new school and I have good friends here. So I think that God was leading me when I came here.*
