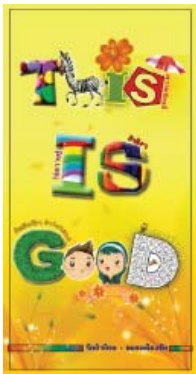




## Thanks for praying...

## October 1-6:

### Floods:

There is a danger of flooding again and the Team asks for your prayers for protection – for us and for many children already being affected. In south and central Thailand bad flooding has meant that schools closed several weeks ago (and children couldn't do the final term exams). Many schools in Nonthaburi and Pathumthani did these exams early because of high water levels, and continual rain.

**And health** - as well as affecting businesses the persistent rain has led to a lot of flu-like sickness. This has hit several on the Team. Thanks for praying with us about this situation.

### Responding to the Lessons:

Answers from some children when they're asked what is different for them after doing the lessons.

**Jitsuda (11):** *I'm not afraid of things because now I have Jesus in my life.*

**Thanyanan (13):** *I feel now I'm a person who has value*

**Jiraphan (11):** *I feel joyful now that I have God in me*

**Kittichai (11):** *I am not afraid, and I feel safe when I know that I am special to God.*

**Piyaporn (11):** *I am very glad. Now I know that God is the one who created me and He loves me so much.*

**Maryan (12):** *I'm very happy as I learn many new things*

**Piyathida (12):** *The lessons help me know that I'm a very important person to God. Now I'm very happy.*

**Please pray** that each child will be aware of God speaking to them and each one will have a deep desire to know Jesus as their Lord and Saviour.

## October 7-13

Special prayer requests from Team members ...

**From Doi** - Kanidtha is 11 and wrote, "I want to ask God to help my father be released from prison. The police just arrested him so it's only my mother and me now. I feel very sorry for my parents. I really want my father to be able to come home soon."

**From Fon** - Gus is a girl who now sells tea at the market. Her mother died 4 mths ago. Her father is now with another woman and Gus feels very sad and alone. She is very open to Jesus. Please pray for her.

**From Dang** - Nawaporn is 18. The Team went to her school in Pathumthani 7 yrs ago and after that Nawaporn began our lessons. She finished them all within 18mths and joined SuSu Club to get our teaching leaflets. Now she's moved to a university near our Team base and contacted Doi to meet up. Nawaporn didn't know how to find a church so we invited her to my church. She came and joined the cell group for students. Afterwards she said, "This is my dream come true. I have always wanted to go to church and learn more about God."

Please pray for Nawaporn. Also pray for so many Thai young people who want to go to church but can't. Either they aren't allowed to go, or they don't know what a church is, or there is no church in their area.



### Printing our new Booklet:

Please pray this all goes well, with no hold-ups. We hope to finish the final proof reading this week.

Then we will begin arranging for other church and mission groups in Thailand to help with distribution of the booklets to schools in their area. May God use each booklet to open a child's heart to Himself.



## October 14-20

### Questions from the Lessons:

Many children have questions and they are all different. Its good to see the varied ways that each child interacts with what they're learning.

**Butsakorn (12):** *I felt sorry for Jesus because he never sinned, but he had to suffer for me. Why did those soldiers want to execute Jesus even though he did nothing wrong?*

**Jutima (10):** *I have questions: When you didn't believe in God, did you have sadness in your heart or not? Now that you know God do you have happiness or not? When you didn't believe how is it different from now that you believe?*

**Buangam (12):** *I feel that Jesus loves us so and he sacrificed himself for many people. I want everyone to stop doing wrong so that God won't get tired of having to redeem our sins. If we didn't have God to help us, how will we turn out?*



**Varied reactions to our program in the schools**

### FahSai House:

Up to 40 children come to FahSai in a week for a variety of reasons. For most its because they want to be with people who care for them. Many of these children and teens are from slum areas where life can be very precarious.

Please pray for Kanchana, NoiNon and Jeen as they demonstrate and teach on the potential that each child has in God, and pray that each child will receive Jesus and begin to follow Him.

## October 21-30

### 22nd to 25th - English Camp

For children from Nonthaburi & Pathumthani. Some Fah Sai children will go to this Camp, and Corin will help there as one of the leaders. He asks for prayer that God will anoint him and use him at this camp.

### God gives Answers

**Yodrak:** *After I prayed to God then He helped me and I don't have a problem with my friend like before.*

**Suangveda:** *One day my mum and dad were arguing, so I asked God to help. Later they were reconciled.*

**Natnicha (10):** *One day I was hungry and really wanted some snack food but I had no money. So I asked God to please help me. Then a friend came and shared her snack with me.*

**Pondtip:** *When I can't understand at school or if its exam time I've learnt to ask God to help and He does.*

**Hai (14):** *I never could overcome my problems so I was always ridiculed by class mates. Now that I know Jesus He showed me I have to forgive them. Also I asked Jesus to help me have fewer problems. And I feel that I'm having far less things go wrong for me.*

**Sudarut (13):** *I'm so happy to learn with you. Now I know about Jesus' story and how much God loves us and how He answers us. Doing the puzzles and writing the answers in the lesson is a lot of fun for me.*

### School outreaches next month:

These will be in northeast Thailand (in Udonthani) where we'll work with a small church in a needy area where most children (and their families) know almost nothing about Jesus.

As we prepare for these school outreaches this week, please pray with us that God will prepare the heart of each child who hears about Him next month. And also, that He will prepare and anoint each Team member who goes to these schools.
